- CT = Combined Test in which horse and rider will compete and be judged at Dressage and Stadium Jumping at that level (NO XC!).
- HT = Horse Trials in which horse and rider will compete and be judged at Dressage, Stadium Jumping and XC at that level.
- Ride-a-Test will be for educational purposes only and will not be placed/ribboned in a class.
- ASTM/SEI approved riding helmets are required to be worn by all riders at all times, even for horses and riders who are not competing.
- WITHDRAWLS: Any entries received prior to July 11<sup>th</sup> will have office fees waived in the event of withdrawl prior to closing date. Entries received between July 16 and closing date will receive refund less \$25 office fee (\$10 for dressage test). No refunds after closing date.
- All competitors must abide by MHSA, USEF, and USEA rules and regulations concerning eventing. See www.qpee.org for link to rules. It is your responsibility to know the rules!
- Safety vests are required for Intro Novice HT. Safety vests are optional for Green as Grass but STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.
- XC Pinny insert holder required for all HT divisions
- Competitors may not ride more than two horses in HT and CT combined. Competitors may ride a third horse in dressage ride-a-test.
- All competitors must send proof of their horse's negative Coggins dated within the last 12 months or you cannot compete! Email or text photo is fine
- Warm-up will be permitted in designated areas before Dressage and Show Jumping. The XC course will be CLOSED TUESDAY JULY 30<sup>TH</sup>, 2024 AT 9:00 AM, however there will be a XC Schooling Day the day before the mini event, on Saturday, August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024 for a fee (\$40).
- No stabling on the grounds, stabling available at the National Equestrian Center (636-561-8080).
- Concessions will be available on the grounds.
- Remember all Stadium and XC is held at a distance from the trailering area, so allow enough time to walk your courses and get to Stadium for your start time.
- For bounced check an additional fee of \$45 will be added to your entry fees.
- The jumping phases will run back to back for all HT entries. You will be assigned a Stadium time and have 15 minutes to make your way to the XC start box. Please bring all equipment/items you will need for XC with you. Remember, all Stadium is held at a distance away, so allow enough time to walk your courses and get to Stadium for your start time.
- Please fill out entry form completely and include entry fee and Coggins. An entry is considered late if all fees are not included!
- I understand and agree that neither the Organizers, Queeny Park Equestrian Events, nor St. Louis County Parks accepts any liability for any accident, injury, or death to riders, owners, horses, attendants, or spectators.

## QUEENY PARK EQUESTRIAN EVENTS, INC.'s AGREEMENT FOR RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

Notice of Dangerous Activity: Horseback riding is an equine activity which poses inherent risks of death, personal injury, or property damage, including the risks of head injury, the physical and mental incapacity that can result from head injuries, and including a significantly increased risk of death.

Horses, even the most well trained, are often unpredictable and difficult or impossible to control. The undersigned Participant is hereby given notice of the risks inherent in equestrian activities, including (1) the propensity of a horse to behave in dangerous ways which may result in death, serious injury, or property damage to the Participant, other participants in QUEENY PARK EQUESTRIAN EVENTS, INC. events, or members of the public; (2) the inability to predict a horse's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons, or animals; (3) hazards of surface or subsurface conditions, field or road conditions; (4) inability of even properly built and maintained riding equipment, obstacles and courses to withstand the power of a panicked or misbehaving horse; (5) the inability of any rider to control any horse; and (6) conduct of other Participants and their horses or the public.

Helmet Recommendation: Wearing an ASTM/SEI certified riding helmet while engaged in QUEENY PARK EQUESTRIAN EVENTS, INC. events can significantly reduce my risk of, and the severity of, head injuries suffered in any equestrian riding accident. QUEENY PARK EQUESTRIAN EVENTS, INC. requires that ALL Participants and their guests wear an ASTM/SEI certified helmet at all times while mounted at and during QUEENY PARK EQUESTRIAN EVENTS, INC. events and activities.

I wish to participate in activities with QUEENY PARK EQUESTRIAN EVENTS, INC., such as trail riding, lessons, training, stadium jumping, schooling events, schooling shows, rated shows, clinics and cross country horseback riding.

I acknowledge that activities including, but not limited to, trail riding, lessons, training, stadium jumping, schooling events, schooling shows, rated shows, clinics and cross country horseback riding, which may include riding over fences or other obstacles, and walking, climbing, and/or riding in steep and/or rough terrain, are dangerous activities. I wish to participate in these activities knowing they are of a dangerous nature. I accept and assume all the risks of personal injury, including death, and any damage to my property.

In exchange for being permitted to participate in these activities, the undersigned Participant hereby releases and forever discharges QUEENY PARK EQUESTRIAN EVENTS, INC., ITS DIRECTORS, MEMBERS, VOLUNTEERS, EMPLOYEES, OR GUESTS, AND/OR ANY LAND OWNERS, LAND HOLDERS, MAKING PROPERTY OR EQUIPMENT AVAILABLE TO QUEENY PARK EQUESTRIAN EVENTS, INC. from any claim of any kind, for any injury, including death, and any damage to this property, whether from anyone's negligence or any other cause, arising out of my participation in dangerous activities including, but not limited to trail riding, lessons, training, stadium jumping, schooling events, schooling shows, rated shows, clinics and cross country horseback riding. This release is binding on my heirs, executors, assigns, administrators, and anyone who may legally make a claim for me or my estate. I will defend and keep those released by this agreement free of any damages or costs because of any such claims including all causes of action brought by my guests who have not signed a waiver.
